- Any entry that includes a mixture of adult and juvenile participants must enter the appropriate Adult Class.
- Juveniles to be classed as a juvenile you must be under 18 years old on 1st September.
- Juvenile Entrants must be accompanied by a suitable number of adult parents or guardians who are not in costume.

<u>Wessex GP Circuit Classes</u> should conform to the criteria laid down in the current Wessex GP Circuit Competition Rules. Classes 10 & 11 – Walking Groups should have a minimum of 3 participants.

<u>Classes 21, 22 & 23 – Non-Wessex GP Circuit Floats</u> should have a minimum of 6 participants on board excluding the driver, must comply with current VSO requirements and have suitable insurance.

<u>Classes 24 & 25 – Non-Wessex GP Circuit Non-VSO Floats</u> should have a minimum of 4 participants on board excluding the driver, must comply with the current VSO Exemption Rules and have suitable insurance.

To comply with VSO Exemption Rules this should be a single decorated unit not more than 2.55 metres wide (approx. 8ft 4ins) and not charging membership or other fees.

They would still need to comply with all the Construction and Use Regulations that apply to all road going vehicle and trailers. Class 26 – Non-Wessex Decorated Hand Drawn Trolley may have two or more pushing/pulling the trolley.

<u>Class 26A – Non Wessex Decorated Hand Drawn Trolley, Cycle or Pram</u> may have only one pushing/pulling the trolley.

<u>Class 28 – Majorettes & Dance Teams</u> – Must not hold up the procession to display or counter-march.

- If trophies are damaged do not attempt repairs Return to the Trophy Officer ASAP
- Trophy Engraving: Winners may have their name & the year engraved on trophies at their own expense EXCEPT for the Best in Carnival Cup and Best Gillingham Entry Cup, which Gillingham Carnival Committee will have engraved at their expense.

GILLINGHAM CARNIVAL 2024 ~ Saturday 4th October Grand Illuminated Evening Procession RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) All Entry Forms to be returned by Saturday 13th September, late entries accepted at the discretion of the Procession Secretary.
- 2) All persons enter the procession at their own risk.
- 3) Gillingham Carnival Committee accepts no liability for any injury, loss or damage to persons or property at this or any other event organised for or by them.
- 4) It is the responsibility of entrants to safeguard any children or vulnerable adults who may be part of their entry.
- 5) It is the responsibility of entrants to ensure any licence required is obtained eg The Music Licence from PPL PRS.
- 6) It is the responsibility of entrants to ensure appropriate insurance cover is obtained for their entry.
- 7) It is the responsibility of entrants to obtain a VSO as appropriate and to ensure that it is properly adhered to. Please check on the Avon and Somerset Constabulary website for guidance on VSO requirements. https://www.avonandsomerset.police.uk/advice/vehicles-and-roads/vehicle-special-order-for-carnivals/
- 8) No entry is to exceed 5.5m in height (approx. 18ft), due to overhead wires, and 30m in length (98ft 6ins).
- 9) Entries must be for the class that is applicable. Entries that are entered into an incorrect class may be transferred to a more appropriate class or disqualified, either before or after judging takes place. The Procession Secretary's decision will be final in this respect. Every effort will be made to notify the entry but this may not always be possible.
- 10) One person over 18 years old is to be authorised and named as the Responsible Person, and will be responsible for all participants. The Responsible Person must ensure that all participants connected with the entry are aware of the Rules and Conditions of Entry.
- 11) No alcohol is to be carried on or with the Entry or to be consumed by entrants.
- 12) No articles are to be thrown from floats/vehicles. Distribution of articles must be by walkers only.
- 13) No animals or livestock of any kind will be accepted as an entry or part thereof.
- 14) Entries must be in the assembly area by 6.00pm, no vehicles will be admitted after this time.
- 15) Entries may arrive at the Assembly Area from 4.00pm, if entries arrive before this time they may have to be moved into the correct position.
- 16) Entries should check-in with the Assembly Marshals on arrival at the Assembly Area. This is a safety requirement and also helps with marshalling arrangements.
- 17) Marshals Instructions please obey marshals' instructions; they may not have time to explain the whys and wherefores but all decisions are made for the good of the carnival as a whole. Public and participant safety is their prime concern at all times.
- 18) If an Entrant's arrival is delayed please contact the Chief Marshal, Tim Kingsmill on 07507 679 410 or Carnival Chairperson, Mary Bailey on 07518 071 092 or Procession Secretary, Kath Outram on 07732 434 295 and every effort will be made to include you in the procession.
- 19) If an Entrant is unable to attend please notify the Procession Secretary ASAP.
- 20) Entries must stay in the position allocated at the Assembly Area until called into procession order by a Marshal.
- 21) A START sign will be displayed. The route will be broken up into sections so that judging can be done fairly, please be aware of Judges En-route.
- 22) Entrants must not approach the judges in order to discuss or dispute the judgment.
- 23) If the Procession halts for more than 2 minutes judging will be suspended to allow entrants to rest.
- 24) Entries must make every effort to keep up with the flow of the procession to avoid undue gaps appearing in the procession.
- 25) In the event of emergency Entries should pull over to the left hand side to allow emergency vehicles to pass.
- 26) Vehicle breakdowns should be reported to the nearest Marshal without delay.
- 27) At the end of the route a FINISH sign will be displayed after which Entries must proceed as far as possible into the Dispersal Area. Those wishing to dismantle should go as far as possible into the dispersal area before pulling over to the left hand side so allowing others to pass. Do not block the roadway as this can cause hold ups which tailback and hold up the Procession on the route itself.
- 28) Entries disregarding rules and conditions of entry will be reported to the Procession Secretary or Chief Marshal, which may result in points being deducted or disqualification and removal from the procession.
- 29) Gillingham Carnival Committee reserves the right to refuse or remove any entry.
- 30) Trophies are to be returned by 30th June of the following year.
- 31) Lost or damaged Trophies will be repaired or replaced as appropriate by Gillingham Carnival Committee and the winning entrant charged for the repair or replacement. Do not attempt to repair damaged trophies yourselves.
